

## Rangatahi Ātea Fund

Fund available for Youth-Led initiatives focused on positive outcomes for Raahui Pookeka Rangatahi (Huntly Young People)









The Rangatahi Ātea Fund (RAF) has been established through the Huntly CAYAD Project. Letari Tepana is the Huntly CAYAD Coordinator and the programme focusses on reducing the drug-related harm to young people. You can apply for up to \$500 per project.

## To be eligible for this fund your project must:

- Be Youth-Led
  - Young people are involved in the design, delivery and evaluation of the project
- Benefit Huntly Young People
  - Outcomes must aim to benefit Huntly Young People directly
- Aim to address an AoD (Alcohol and Other Drugs) related issue
  Project needs to incorporate an identified AoD issue relevant to Huntly Young People
- Have the support of two local Community Groups/Marae/Agencies
  - Project supported (by letter and/or participation) by local community

You may submit your application to the **CAYAD Coordinator** at any time. The application will then go to the **RAF Panel** who will respond within **four weeks** of receiving your completed application.

Successful applicants will be invited to meet with the **RAF Panel** to discuss outcomes of the project and the accountability process.

Funds will be paid within two weeks of successful applicants meeting with the RAF Panel.
